- **ITEM 1** The meeting was called to order at 9:30 am. There was no public comment.
- It was moved by Tim Johnson, seconded by Norik Naraghi and carried "To approve the minutes of the July 16, 2015, September 24, 2015. And December 17, 2015 board meetings."
- The financial report showed \$229,731.81 as of December 17, 2015. It was moved by Ward Burroughs, seconded by Tim Johnson and carried "That the bills as presented for January 2016 be approved and paid."
- It was moved by Ward Burroughs, seconded by Norik Naraghi and carried "That the board meet monthly instead of quarterly."
- **ITEM 5** Report on Conflict of Interest Form 700 due date. SO NOTED.
- A report was given by the board secretary on the outcome of the December 17, 2015 public hearing on the Proposition 218 protest vote.
 - <u>bi.</u> The board directed the water consultant to send letters to landowners that are not within the Eastside Water District, but were inadvertently sent notices about the Proposition 218 protest vote.
 - <u>bii</u>. It was moved by Ward Burroughs, seconded by Norik Naraghi and carried "To authorize the per-acre charge for 2016 per the October 16, 2015 report and directed the secretary to draft a resolution for the Diffused Surface Water Project charges that will be submitted to Merced and Stanislaus County Auditor-Controller Offices,"
 - **biii.** It was moved by Ward Burroughs, seconded by Tim Johnson and carried "To authorize a Scope of Work to secure temporary water rights for flows of Sand and Mustang Creeks with a maximum cost of \$25,000, and to meet with the Department of Fish and Game to determine the process.
 - **biv.** The Scope of Work to design and install groundwater recharge facilities for diffused surface water and temporary water right flows was tabled for the February meeting.

<u>bv.</u> The authorization of a short-term loan to provide interim funding for 2016 work was put on hold by the board.

A status report on the progress with the Ballico Cortez Water District in regard to the East Turlock Sub-Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency Formation was given. It was moved by Tim Johnson, seconded Ward Burroughs by and carried "To authorize the water consultant to send a letter to the Ballico Cortez Water District regarding the status of the Ballico Cortez Water District and Eastside Water District Memorandum of Understanding to implement the East Turlock Sub-Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency."
