ITEM 4 The financial report showed \$1,220,555.43. as of June 29, 2018. It was moved by

Ward Burroughs, seconded by Wes Sperry, and carried unanimously that the

bills as presented for July 2018 be approved and paid.

ITEM 5 It was moved by Tim Johnson, seconded by Ward Burroughs and carried

unanimously to adopt the Eastside Water District Conflict of Interest Code approved by the Fair Political Practices Commission that agrees that the district's statements of economic interest will file their originals with the Stanislaus County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Office, and includes the following amendment:

Designated Positions, Legal Counsel, Assigned Disclosure Category 1 (one).

ITEM 6 It was moved by Tim Johnson, seconded by Wes Sperry and carried

unanimously to direct staff to begin the ACWA JPIA insurance application

process and authorize the board chairman to sign application documents.

The Water Consultant gave an update on the 2018 Land Annexation process. He

stated a letter was being sent to landowners who had not responded for a final

opportunity to be annexed into the district. An information only item.

ITEM 8 Regarding the Diffused Surface Water Project:

a. Dry Creek:

i. Staff gave an update on the recharge efforts. An information only item.

- b. Rouse Lake Area:
 - i. The Water Consultant gave an update on the draft project description of the Rouse Lake Managed Aquifer Recharge Project to the board. An information only item.
- c. Mustang Creek:
 - i. The Water Consultant gave a brief report on Mustang Creek and stated that Wood Rodgers was working on a proposal to install dry wells. An information only item.
- d. Well Monitoring
 - i. The Water Consultant presented a proposal for a well monitoring program, that will be presented to the East Turlock Subbasin (ETS) Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA). **An information only item.**

ITEM 9

There was a brief update on the East Turlock Subbasin Groundwater Sustainability Agency Joint Powers Authority, including a joint opposition letter from the San Joaquin River GSAs to the State Water Resources Control Board regarding revisions to the proposed Bay-Delta Plan amendments. **An information only item**. The EWD board directed legal counsel to prepare and submit an opposition letter from the district.
