Minutes of the Regular Scheduled Meeting of Board of Directors Eastside Water District

Thursday, February 16, 2023, 9:00 AM

Chairman Tim Johnson called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. at the Cortez Hall, 12937 North Cortez Avenue, Turlock, CA 95380 and via Zoom.

Directors Present: Ty Angle, Ward Burroughs, Carl Evers III Tim Johnson, Norik Naraghi (on-line), Wes Sperry, and Maryse Suppiger (on-line).

<u>Item 2</u> Public Comment: There was no public comment.

Consent Calendar: It was moved by Member Ward Burroughs, seconded by Member Carl Evers, III, and carried to approve the consent calendar. Roll Call Vote: Ty Angle-Yes, Ward Burroughs-Yes, Carl Evers III-Yes, Tim Johnson-Yes, Norik Naraghi-Yes, Wes Sperry-Yes, and Maryse Suppiger-abstained.

<u>Item 4</u> Watershed Update

- a. Regarding Merced Irrigation District infrastructure improvements; there were no updates.
- b. There was a brief discussion regarding Phase 2 of the Upland Pipeline Project, which includes an evaluation of the frequency and magnitude of available surplus water supplies from Dry, Sand and Mustang Creeks for potential appropriation through temporary and/or standard water rights from the State Water Resources Control Board, Division of Water Rights. It was moved by Member Ty Angle, seconded by Member Ward Burroughs and carried unanimously to approve the Phase 2 contract with Provost and Pritchard of the Upland Pipeline Project for an amount not to exceed sixty-seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$67,800.00). Roll Call Vote: Ty Angle-Yes, Ward Burroughs-Yes, Carl Evers III-Yes, Tim Johnson-Yes, Norik Naraghi-Yes, Wes Sperry-Yes, and Maryse Suppiger-Yes.

Item 5 Wood Rodgers Evaluation of Replenishment Property off the Highline Canal

- a. Phase 1 of the Final Report was briefly reviewed. There was discussion that properties that are ready to be connected to the canal and receive water should be part of the ranking. **This item was information only.**
- b. Phase 2 of the project was discussed and it was recommended by the General Manager to do Tasks 6, 7a and 7b of Phase 2, which would be a Feasibility Study. It was moved by Member Ward Burroughs, seconded by Member Ty Angle and carried unanimously to approve Tasks 6, 7a and 7b of Phase 2 for an amount not to exceed seventy-seven thousand dollars (\$77,886.00). Roll Call Vote: Ty Angle-Yes, Ward Burroughs-Yes, Carl Evers III-Yes, Tim Johnson-Yes, Norik Naraghi-Yes, Wes Sperry-Yes, and Maryse Suppiger-Yes.

<u>Item 6</u> Discuss Possible Policy for Financial Reimbursement to EWD Landowners for Infrastructure Projects Built to Expand Recharge and In-Lieu Water Use

There was further discussion about criteria and cost benefit. The Ad Hoc Committee would meet before the March board meeting and bring their recommendations back to the board.

Item 7 Update on Mustang Creek

- a. The General Manager reported the permit for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) for Mustang Creek has been received. She is working to find a company to do a cleaning in the Spring after the rains. **This item was information only.**
- b. The General Manager said that DWR is working on a date to come and inspect the dam. They are still working on a date to meet with TID to develop an operational agreement. **This item was information only.**
- c. John Lambie, EPUR, gave a report on the Year 2 water quality testing for the Gravity Downwells/Vertical Drains Recharge Pilot Study. **This item was information only.**

Item 8 Multi Benefit Land Repurposing (MLRP)

The Department of Conservation has opened Round 2 of a funding opportunity. Applications are due March 29, 2023. The ETS GSA must submit the grant proposal. There was discussion that Eastside Water District wants to be a partner and will encourage the GSA to submit a proposal.

<u>Item 9</u> East Turlock Subbasin GSA Update:

Sarah Woolf, General Manager, gave a GSP Update that included the following:

- a. The Prop 68 Grant Round 2 application had 82 applications submitted. We should hear if the GSA was awarded in late summer.
- b. The next workshop is March 7. The focus will be pumping management. Postcards and a pilot pumping program application are being mailed.
- c. The GSA approved the EWD loan. It was moved by Member Carl Evers, III, seconded by Member Wes Sperry, and carried to approve the loan retroactively in the amount of four hundred thirty-one thousand five hundred thirty-two dollars (\$431,532.00)/ Roll Call Vote: Ty Angle-Abstain, Ward Burroughs-Yes, Carl Evers III-Yes, Tim Johnson-Yes, Norik Naraghi-Yes, Wes Sperry-Yes, and Maryse Suppiger-Yes.
- d. Accounting Framework will be discussed in closed session.
