- Item 5Levy and Collection of Water Charges 2023-2024Sarah Woolf, General Manager reviewed the letter that will be sent out to landowners as
a follow-up to the postcard. The letter will explain the loan to ETSGSA and details about
the different fees. This item was information only.

Item 6Highline Connection UpdateSarah Woolf reported that both the Daniel's and Mast projects are connected and taking
water. She also stated another landowner who did not receive funds from the project,
but is in the Eastside Water District, is also taking water from the Highline Canal. This item

Item 7 Dry Well Next Steps

Sarah Woolf, General Manager, submitted a written report to the board. Water quality remained excellent over the two-year pilot program. There are issues with the degradation of the down wells due to silt. The designer of the down wells is working on a two-fold solution of cleaning out the current wells and a new design. The board directed staff to submit the final report to the Regional Water Quality Board, to work with Torrent Resources to clean out the existing down wells and design a modification to the

wells for future mitigation of clogging from fine sediment, and to continue to spray Mustang Creek for weed control. **This item was information only.**

- b. Prop 218 Groundwater Pumping Fee There was a kick off meeting. A board workshop has also been set for 1 pm on Wednesday, August 16. The public will be invited.
- c. Workshop –The June 27 was well attended. The pilot portal was demonstrated. At the July Technical Advisory Committee meeting two companies gave presentations of an active dashboard for landowners. After the pilot program is complete, there will be a follow-up work shop scheduled, probably some time in October.
- d. 2023/24 GSA Budget The budget was adopted with a deficit.
- e. Accounting Framework To be discussed in closed session.
- f. Groundwater Pumping Pilot Program There are currently 15 participants in the program.
