3. PROPOSITION 218 PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED GROUNDWATER USE FEE

The Board Chairman will open the Public Hearing and receive comments from the public regarding the proposed Groundwater Use Fee. ETSGSA Consultants will provide an overview of the proposed Groundwater Use Fee. Protests must be submitted by the close of the public hearing to be tabulated.

4. PRESENTATION OF OBJECTIONS TO PROPOSED GROUNDWATER USE FEE AND ETSGSA RESPONSES PURSUANT TO AB 2257

ETSGSA consultants will provide an overview of objections submitted by landowners pursuant to AB 2257, if any, and will present ETSGSA responses, if any, for the Board's consideration. The Board shall exercise its discretion to determine whether the written objections, if any, and ETSGSA's responses warrant clarifications to the proposed fee, a reduction in the proposed fee, further review before making a determination on whether clarification or reduction is needed, or whether to proceed with the public hearing.

5. TABULATION OF THE PROPOSITION 218 GROUNDWATER USE FEE PROTESTS

Following the close of the public input portion of the hearing, SCI Consulting Group will unseal and tabulate the protests in public view. Pursuant to Gov. Code section 53755 (b), only one protest will be counted per parcel. ETSGSA may, if needed, continue the tabulation to a public hearing on a later date, in compliance with the Brown Act.

6. ANNOUNCEMENT OF PROTEST TABULATION RESULTS

Following tabulation of the protests received by ETSGSA and the close of the public hearing, the Board Chairman will announce the tabulation results.

7. ADJOURNMENT
